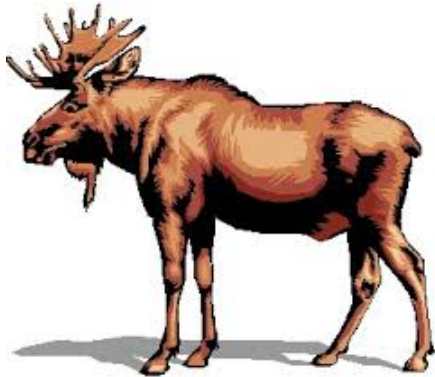

A Word from the Administrator:

A Special Note to Women Members

The closing of our Moose Chapter has presented considerable confusion for our women Moose members. Our women members are vital to our Lodge, so this is an explanation to help with some of the confusion.

The membership for the women's chapter at the Eureka Moose was automatically transferred to the McKinleyville chapter. Therefore if you need to pay your dues you can pay them by check made payable to McKinleyville Moose Chapter 1114. You can also pay on line or in the Eureka Lodge by cash, credit or debit card. Dues are \$35.00.

Many of the women have elected to transfer to the ALL Heart Chapter 3000. The annual dues for All Heart are \$25.00. You can transfer by filling out an application (applications are available in the Eureka Lodge) and a \$10.00 transfer fee. But, to transfer you must have at least two months before your current membership expiration date.

A woman wanting to join can elect either McKinleyville Chapter 1114 or All Heart Chapter 3000. The cost for joining McKinleyville is a one-time \$20.00 registration fee and \$35.00 for dues per year. For All Heart Chapter 3000 the one time registration fee is \$20.00 and the dues are \$25.00 per year.
