## Governors Word/Administrators Corner

### A Word from the Administrator:

Yesterday it happened again. I was apprised of some great ideas on how to improve this Lodge to better serve our members: great Ideas, but, no help was offered. I sometimes believe that many of our members are under the misconception that there is this mysterious staff that is paid to make these things happen. The reality is, nearly all the work in this Lodge is done by volunteers; cooks, servers, bartenders, cleaning, grounds maintenance, repairs, and on and on. In addition, most of our members don't even support the Lodge by attending dinners, breakfasts, or even the Social Quarters. Some may contend that they support the Lodge by paying their dues. That brings me to another point: Many of our most dependable volunteers are women Moose members, even though they cannot now be members of our Lodge. We would be lost without their continued support. The loss of our women's chapter created significant confusion as well as lot more work to process their applications for membership. However, there is a change on the horizon! Moose International is working to dissolve the separation of women and men as members. This change is just around the corner and is long overdue. Fortunately, this move is vigorously supported by most members. I am looking forward to women attending and voting at Lodge meetings, holding officer positions, and bringing new ideas and perspectives to our Lodge operations. At last we will be united in purpose: Women and men standing together to sustain our Lodge into the Future.

As we enter into the holiday season, I wish all of you good health and happiness. Please visit your lodge this holiday season. You might even consider putting on an apron or a tool belt: it opens a whole new perspective!

Hello Fraternal Men and Women:

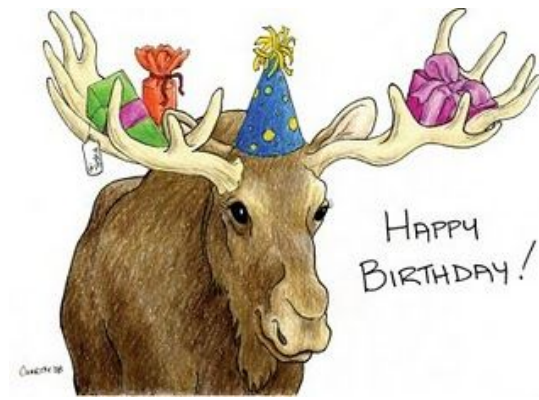

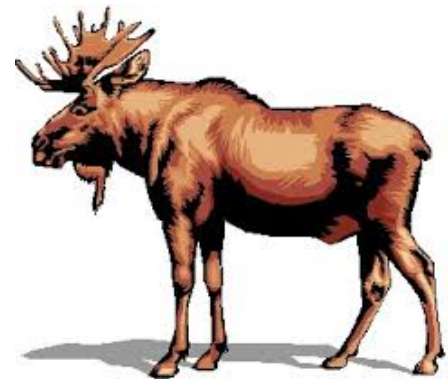
